NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4437) affecting the Footpath 21a from its junction with Tail Sluice for 170m northwards in the BOROUGH OF KING'S LYNN to facilitate Environmental Agency condition surveyor works.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
