What started as an intended exploratory meeting to see who might be interested quickly turned into the inaugural meeting of the "Save our Pub" campaign.

Almost two thirds of those who attended have said that they wish to help and support the project and over 30 have said that they are prepared to give up their time to work on the Steering Committee. We think we have lift off!

The hard work now starts, and the next step is to set up the Steering Committee to share the load and to drive this project forward.
